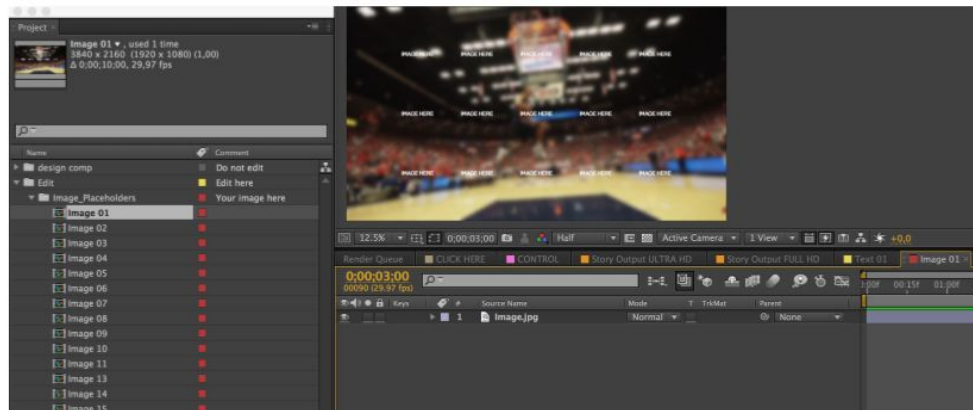

Change in text

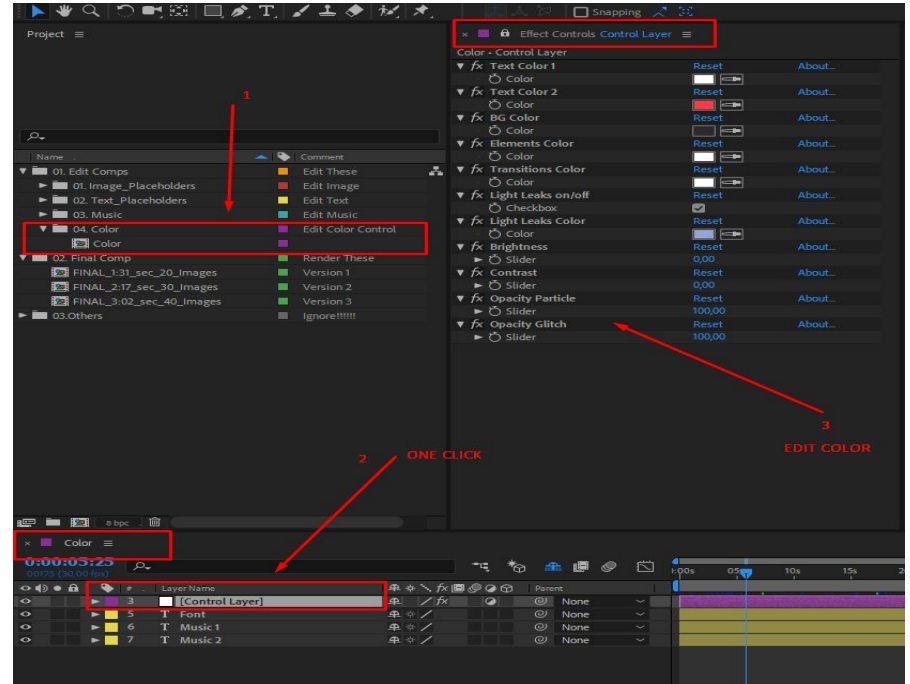

# How to edit colors?

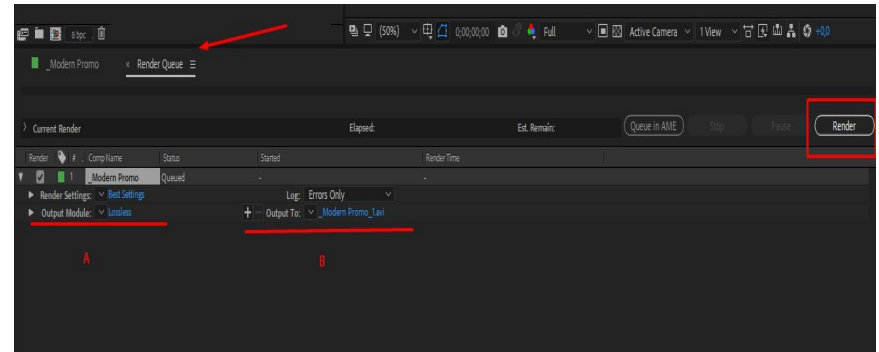
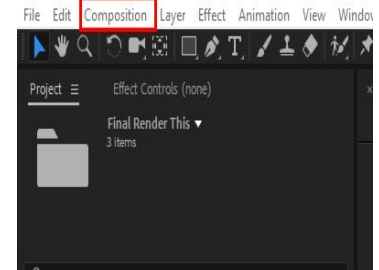
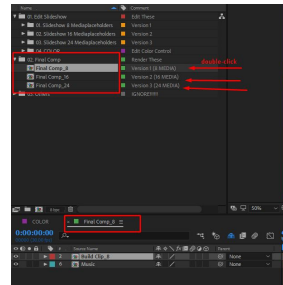
In the folder "Edit" double-click on the composition "Color" and select a layer "Control Layer" with a single click. Click on the panel "Effects Control"
